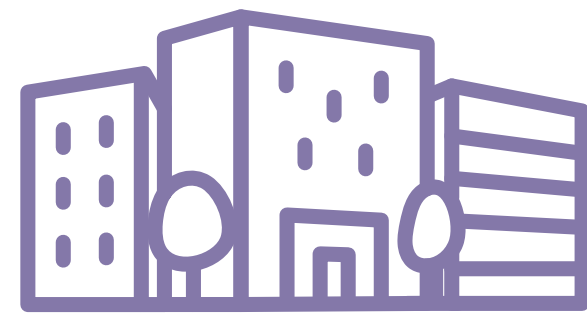


# Neighborhood Power Project

## Ss. Genevieve and Stanislaus Parish Project Summary

The St. Stanislaus building is one of two buildings of the Ss. Genevieve and Stanislaus Bishop & Martyr Parish, a Catholic church that provides faith-based programming and community support in the Belmont-Cragin neighborhood.

Through its partnership with NPP, the facility upgraded its lighting throughout the property, installed high-efficiency appliances, and installed more advanced chiller controls for higher efficiency and control of temperature.

### Future recommended sustainability projects for St. Stanislaus

Install full building automation system

Upgrade lighting controls

Install water aerators for faucets

To cover the \$25,772 cost of the facility's lighting retrofit project, the Parish received nearly \$20,000 in ComEd incentives — on top of the NPP grant.

The lighting retrofit project will reduce the facility's energy usage by approximately 15,848 kWh annually.

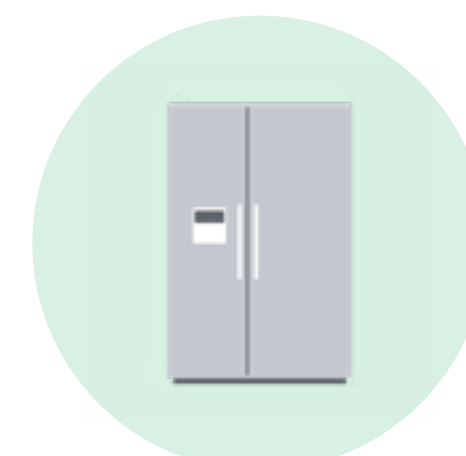
