Green Schools

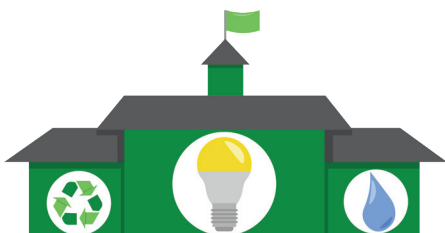
- Work with a K-12 school

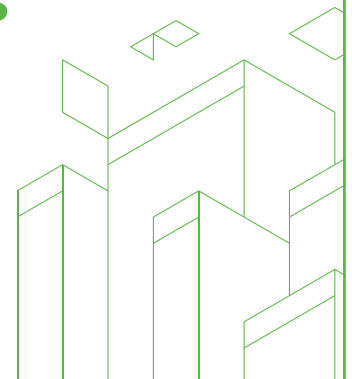
Sustainable Facilities

- 1 calendar year commitment with option to continue
- Individual or paired volunteer team

Commitments:

- 8-12 hours of training over first two months
- 2-5 hours per month working with your building
- Provide support to organization leaders
- Engage with community members
- Participate in meet-ups and provide updates to Illinois Green staff
